

Emergency Laparotomy Collaborative

6 steps to achieve better outcomes.

- 1. Check NEWS/lactate. Start resuscitation with fluids and oxygen. Escalate if appropriate
- 2. Carry out sepsis assessment. If septic, complete sepsis 6 including antibiotics within one hour
- 3. Knife-to-skin within **six** hours of decision to operate
- Use cardiac output monitored goal-directed
 4. fluid therapy intraoperatively and for six hours postoperatively
- 5. Critical care for all patients postoperatively
- **6.** Consultant led care throughout.
